

Call for Presentations

Graduate Women Scotland (GWS) is holding its annual Research Presentation Day.

Each year we invite women postgraduate researchers, who are attached to a Scottish University, to speak to a non-specialist audience about their current projects. This year's Research Presentation Day will be on 4 December and will be held virtually.

The event is an opportunity for the speakers to reach out to the public about their work in a friendly and supportive environment. Each selected student will give a 15-minute presentation on their research (in any field) with 5 minutes at the end for questions. A diverse panel of academics will be in attendance, as well as members of the public, to provide feedback to the speakers.

There will also be an opportunity for some students to present a poster instead of giving a presentation.

Abstracts are due by 22 October, and all shortlisted speakers will be notified by 4 November via the email submitted. The selection process for invited speakers will be by peer review.

Graduate Women Scotland works to promote the advancement of women and girls worldwide through education. GWS is a part of GWI which has consultative status with the UN.

- The poster presentation will occur during the lunch break, with an opportunity for the audience to ask questions over the break
